CHARLES J. MARSHALL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP—\$500

1. Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is as a memorial to Charles J. Marshall. This scholarship is based on scholastic achievement, participation in school or civic activities.

2. Amount and Payment Method

- a. It is the intent of the Foundation to grant one scholarship. (The Foundation may grant more than one scholarship in certain circumstances.)
- b. The scholarship is initially established at \$500. Payment will be made equitably after successful completion of semester/term. Grades must be submitted to the Foundation before payment can be made. Disbursement will be made directly to the student after all required documentation has been submitted and reviewed.

3. Qualifications

- a. The applicant must be a graduate of Central High School District 301 and attended for least two years.
- b. The applicant must have been accepted to the school or his/her choice.

4. Selection Committee

- a. The selection committee shall consist of at least three 301 CEF members.
- b. The committee members shall not be related to any applicant.
- c. Only those completing applications will be considered.
- d. One alternate will be chosen, if available.
- d. The CEF selection committee has final/sole discretion for selection and disbursement.

5. Application and Awarding

- a. Applications may be obtained from the CHS Guidance Counselors or available on the website 301foundation.org and are due back at the time determined by Counselor.
- b. The Scholarship will be awarded at Central High School's Honor Night.
