***301 Central Education
Foundation Scholarship***

1. Purpose

This scholarship is based on scholastic achievement, participation in community or school service, and demonstration of leadership in the community or district schools

2. Amount and Payment Method

- a. It is the intent of the Foundation to grant one scholarship.
- b. The scholarship is \$500. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to schools upon receipt of a student final grades at the completion of the first semester (fall semester following the candidate's graduation). Expenses for room and board, excluding security deposit, will qualify hereunder, limited however to the amount the college or university charges for its on-campus room and board program.
- c. No cash will be awarded other than for reimbursement of incidental academic related expenses, required for the course work, and a receipt is provided. Recipient may not request payment of reimbursement for expenses, which are or have been covered through any other financial aid source other than student loans obtained for tuitions and related expenses.

All unused scholarship funds revert back to the general fund by the college after one year if not applied for by the recipient. If recipient decides to no longer attend the college or university to which payment has been made, any and all unused scholarship funds must be returned to the Foundation directly from the college or university. Recipient includes alternate pick.

3. Qualifications

- a. The applicant must be a graduate of Central High School District 301 and attended for least two years.
- b. The applicant must have been accepted to the school or his/her choice.
- c. The applicant must be an honor roll student at the completion of senior year.

4. Selection Committee

- a. The selection committee shall consist of at least three 301 CEF members.
- b. The committee members shall not be related to any applicant.
- c. Only those completing applications will be considered.
- d. The CEF selection committee has final/sole discretion for disbursement.

5. Application and Awarding

- a. Applications may be obtained from the CHS Guidance Counselors or available on the website 301foundation.org
- b. The Scholarship will be awarded at Central High School's Honor Night.
